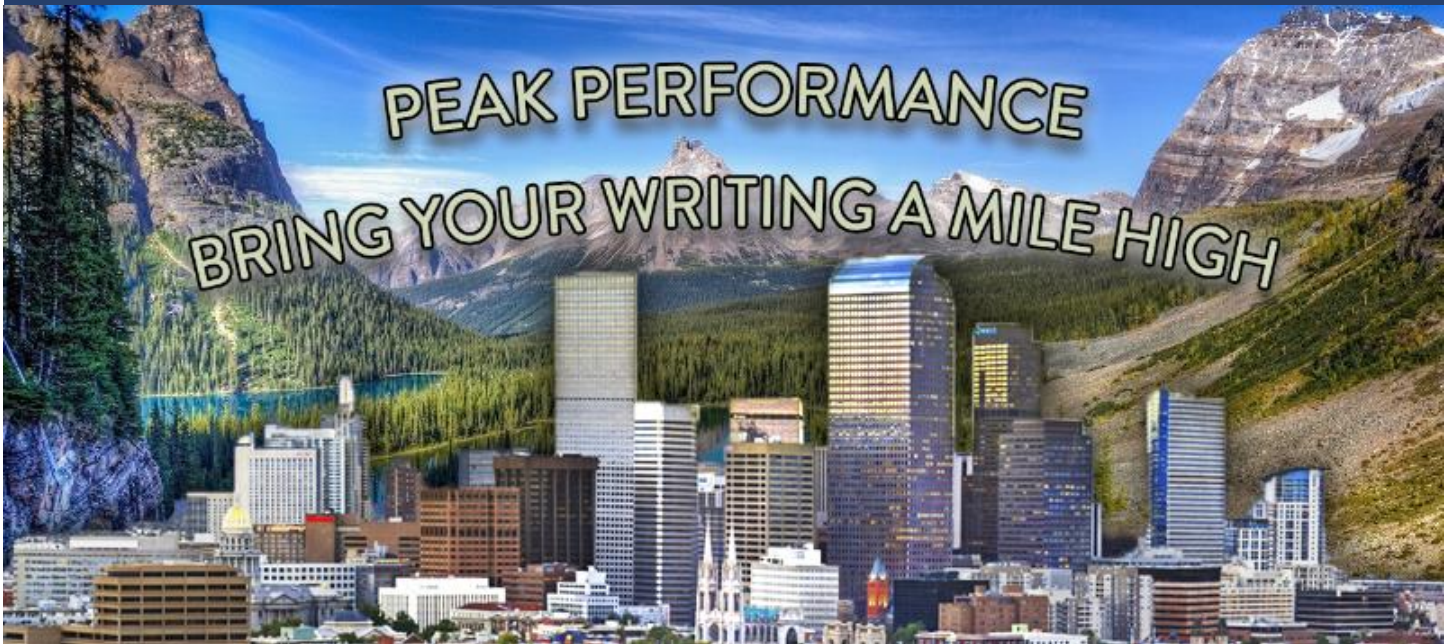

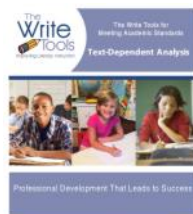
Informative/Explanatory, June 27-29, 2017 8:00am - 4:30pm Cost: \$499 (Includes Training Manual and Writing Software)

This **three-day** training is your introduction to The Write Tools and where teachers begin. The instructional strategies presented are woven into a student-friendly Writing Routine that helps students write successful paragraphs and essays. Participants walk away with skills and strategies for instructing students in writing based on the Common Core State Standards, 6 + 1 Traits, differentiation and best practices. We also introduce a wealth of strategies for reading and comprehending Informational text, and provide practice in text-based writing.



Primary/Level 1 Option for Day 3 June 29, 2017, 8:00am - 4:30pm

This **one-day** session vigorously engages participants in reading and writing strategies and techniques to teach writing and responding to text to Primary, ELL, or Special Needs students. Informative/Explanatory workshop participants can choose to attend this session or the regular Informative/Explanatory Day 3 session focused on multiparagraph/essay writing. **Also available as a single-day workshop**.**



Text-Dependent Analysis June 30, 2017, 8:00 am - 4:30 pm

This **one-day** follow-up training to explicitly teach tools for proficient Text-Dependent Analysis. This training builds upon students' I/E writing skills to include effectively citing evidence to support their work. **Prerequisite:** Participants must complete the I/E workshop prior to attending this session.



Narrative: Real or Imagined, July 11-13, 2017, 8:00am - 4:30pm Cost: \$499 (Includes Training Manual and Writing Software)

This **three-day** workshop includes Responding to Literature, which involves showing written evidence that you comprehend both fiction and poetry. We will practice this at all levels. We will also teach the Writing Routine for both Real and Imagined stories, which will prepare students to continue or finish stories they begin reading, as well as write complete narratives independently. In addition, this workshop provides effective strategies for building vocabulary and analyzing poetry. It is helpful if participants are familiar with our Writing Routine for Informative/Explanatory Writing for the Responding to Literature day.



Opinion/Argumentation July 18-20, 2017, 8:00am - 4:30pm Cost: \$499 (Includes Training Manual and Writing Software)

This **two- or three-day** workshop provides K-12 teachers with differentiated strategies for Opinion Writing (K-5), Argumentation (6-12), and Research Papers and Projects (Grades 3-12). Participants can choose to attend two or three days. On Day 1, we offer Opinion Writing (Grades 3-5), providing strategies to help students form an opinion based first on personal experiences, followed by opinions based on text. Day 2 focuses on Research Papers and Projects for all grade levels. Day 3 is spent exploring the art of Argumentation Writing (Grades 6-12). Participants can choose to attend Day 1/Day 2, Day 2/Day 3 or all three days.

Prerequisite: It is helpful if participants are familiar with our Writing Routine for Informative/Explanatory Writing.
